An exhibitor whose dog wins an award must be present to accept the award when it is presented, or they may appoint a representative to accept the award for them. Prizes, trophies and ribbons will not be mailed or delivered.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephoned, faxed or telegraphed entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

Obedience & Rally Entry Limitations - please read carefully - Obedience: According to Chapter 1, Section 27 of the AKC Obedience Regulations, each judge will be limited to a total of four hours of judging time per trial. Entries will be limited based on the maximum number of dogs allowed per hour for each class according to the Obedience Regulations. Entries will be taken in the order received as time limits are calculated for each judge. **Rally** is limited to 80 dogs per trial.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Please **TYPE OR PRINT** all information.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within five (5) days of the show, the Trial Secretary should be contacted.

MOVE-UPS ACCEPTED, requests for move-ups must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING The Club and/or its Trial Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog by holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Dogs must be kept on lead except when in the judging ring.

THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, FAIRGROUNDS, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

There will be no drilling or intensive or abusive training on the Trial Grounds or Fairgrounds (AKC-Obedience Reg. Ch 2, Sect. 26). All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard)
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A K C (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3)
