**From Oakland Area**, Take Highway 580 Eastbound to Hayward and exit on the Hayward exit. Continue on Foothill Blvd into downtown Hayward. Turn right onto "A" Street, two blocks, left onto Mission Blvd for several blocks. Turn left onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up hill, and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At stop sign, turn left and proceed to rear of campus. Turn right at stop sign, and right into Lot K (Theatre).


All special awards are offered for scores earned in the REGULAR OBEDIENCE TRIAL classes, except where otherwise specified. Qualifying scores are required. The term "dog" refers to either sex. In case of a tie for any award, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits its right to a prize. No prizes will be mailed. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for a Special Award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award.

Highest Scoring Dog in Regular Obedience Trial Classes ............ \$30.00 Cash Prize Highest Combined Score in Open B & Utility ...... \$25.00 Cash Prize Highest Combined Score in RALLY Advanced B & Excellent B ..... \$25.00 Cash Prize Offered to the dog earning the highest combined score from Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B classes, qualifying scores required in both classes. In the case of several dogs having the same combined score, then times from both classes will be added, with lowest combined time being the winner. In the case that there is a tie of both combined scores and combined times, then the winner will be determined by run-off at the conclusion of Rally judging using the Excellent B course used earlier in the trial. Handlers may have 5 minutes to re-walk the course.

San Lorenzo DTC will use a "Self-Service" Special Awards Binder to determine the winners of the following special awards. IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ANY OF THE AWARDS LISTED BELOW, you must enter your armband number on the tote sheet for each award you are in competition for. Awards will be based on the information the handlers have entered on the tote sheets only. If you do not complete the tote sheet information at the trial, you will not be eligible for the Special Awards. High in Trial and High Combined are not required complete the tote sheet. Only scores earned from the REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES are eligible.

# Notice To Exhibitors

- CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or telephoned, entries cannot be accepted. Entries 1 without fees cannot be accepted. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- 2. CHANGES, ADDITIONS, OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received IN WRITING prior to close of entries. Email and faxed changes are acceptable. Telephone changes are not acceptable. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such entries
- An AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.00 per 3. entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in an AKC Member or Licensed Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.
- ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the 4 published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian, or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- 5. BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than 1/2 hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
- 6. THE WELL-BEING OF DOGS and participants is of paramount importance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fee(s) will be made. DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS IN A HOT VEHICLE.
- 7. CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven (7) days of the show, the Trial Secretary should be contacted.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, particolor), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
